7. Tie the ear loops to the corners of the mask.

Method 2: Sewn Face Mask

1. Cut two rectangles of fabric measuring 6" x 9".
2. Cut a rectangle of filter material measuring 6" x 6".

3. Place the filter material between the two fabric rectangles and align the edges.
4. Sew around the edges of the mask, leaving a small opening for turning.
5. Turn the mask right side out and press flat.
6. Create ear loops by cutting four pieces of elastic or ribbon measuring 6 inches long.
7. Fold the ear loops in half and sew them to the inside of the mask.

Fitting and Usage

1. Place the face mask over your nose and mouth, ensuring a snug fit.
2. Adjust the ear loops or head ties to fit comfortably.
3. The mask should cover your chin and extend up to the bridge of your nose.
4. Avoid touching your face while wearing the mask.
5. Replace the filter material regularly, especially after prolonged use.

Safety Precautions

- Always wash your hands before handling or wearing a face mask.
- Do not wear a face mask for more than 4 hours at a time.
- If you experience any difficulty breathing, remove the mask immediately.
- Dispose of used masks in a sealed plastic bag.

- Do not share face masks with others.

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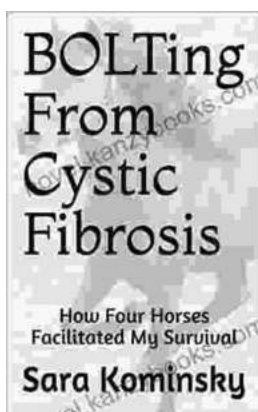
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
