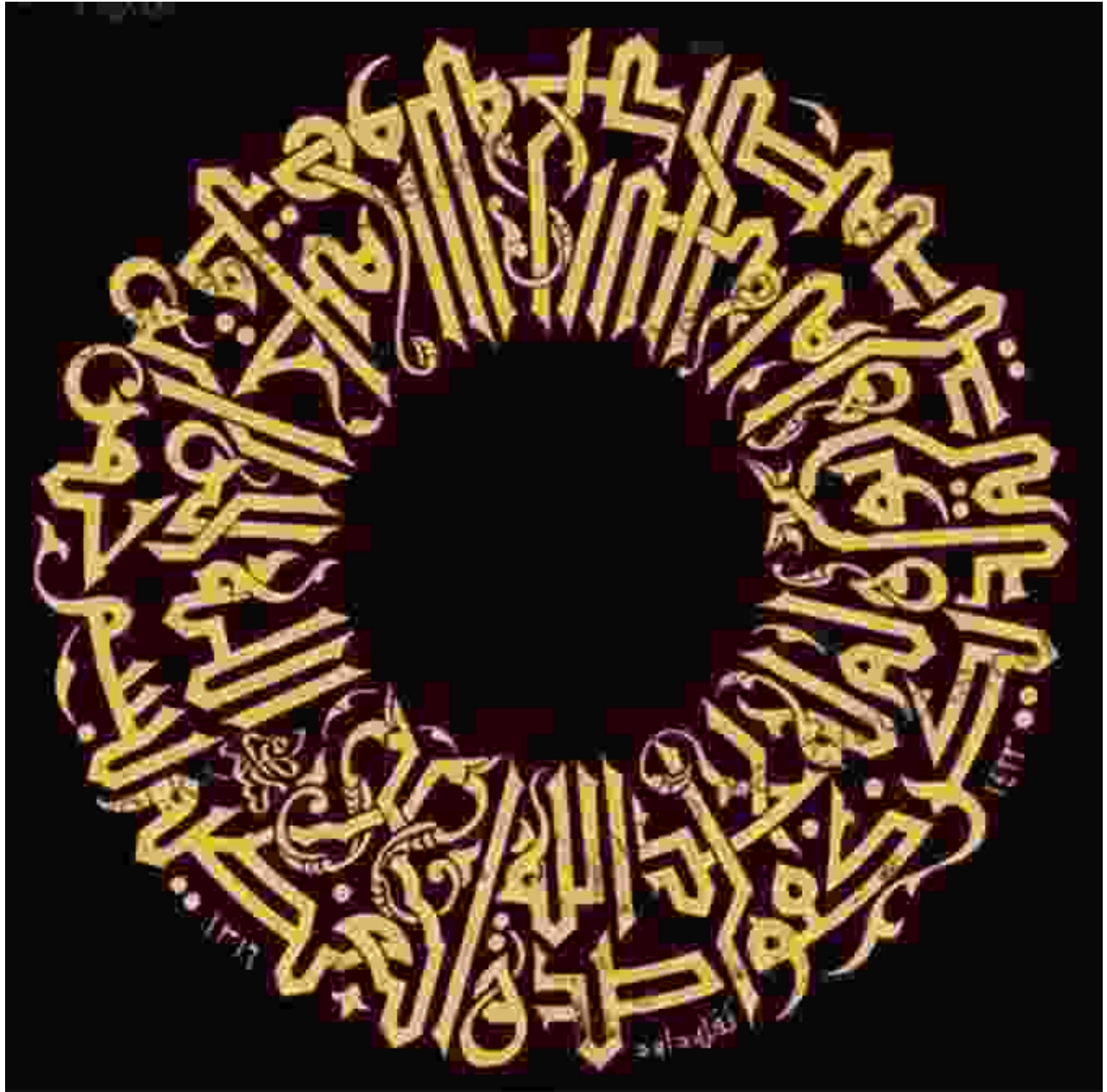
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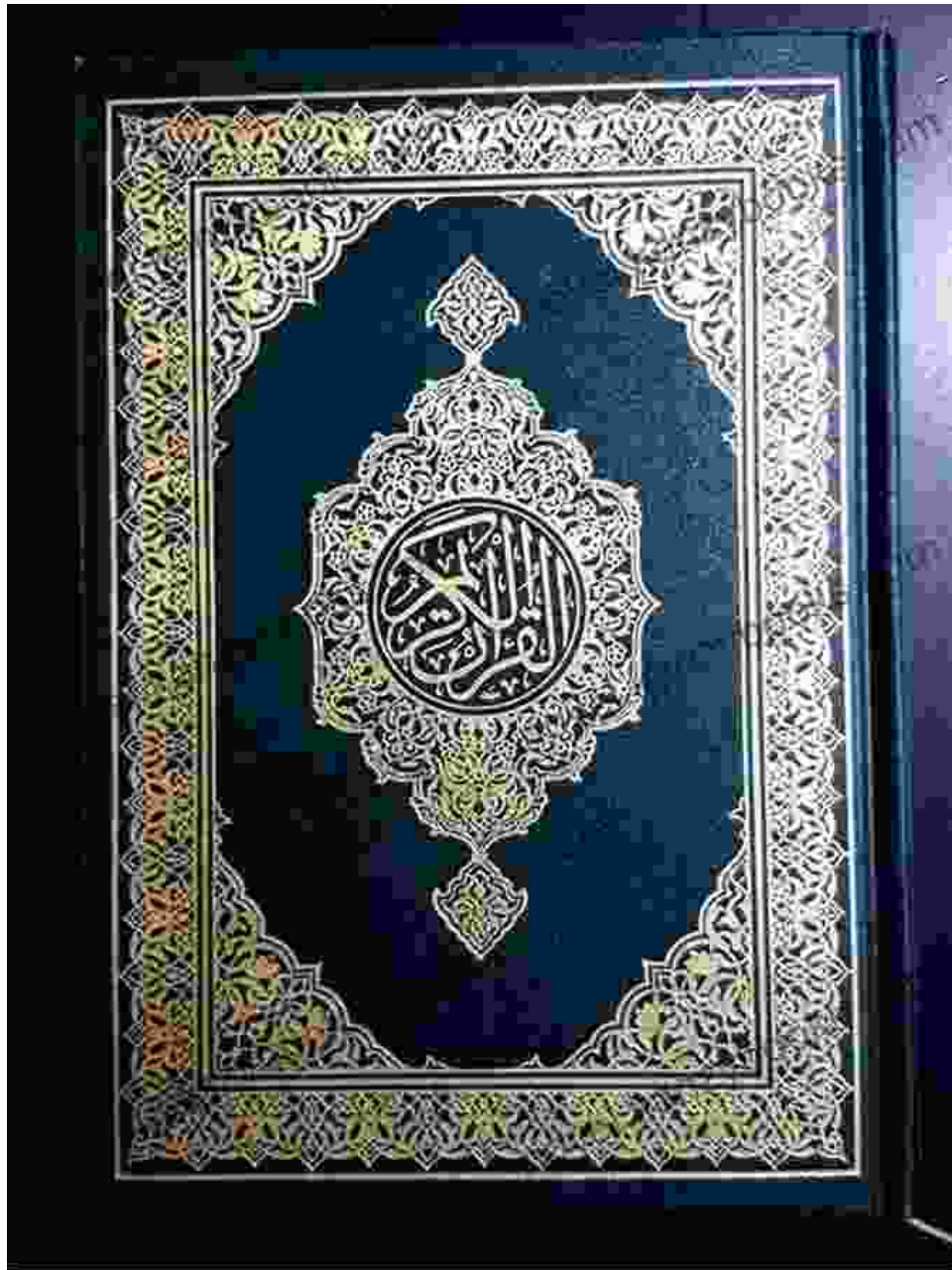
Chapter 1: The Essence of Tawheed: Proclaiming the Oneness of God

Chapter 4: The Power of Forgiveness: A Path to Inner Peace

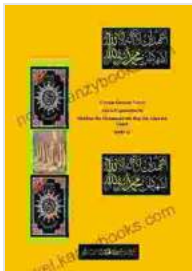

Verse 8: "And say, 'My Lord, forgive and have mercy, for You are the best of those who forgive.'" (Quran 23:118)



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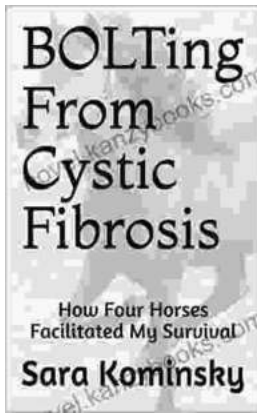
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
