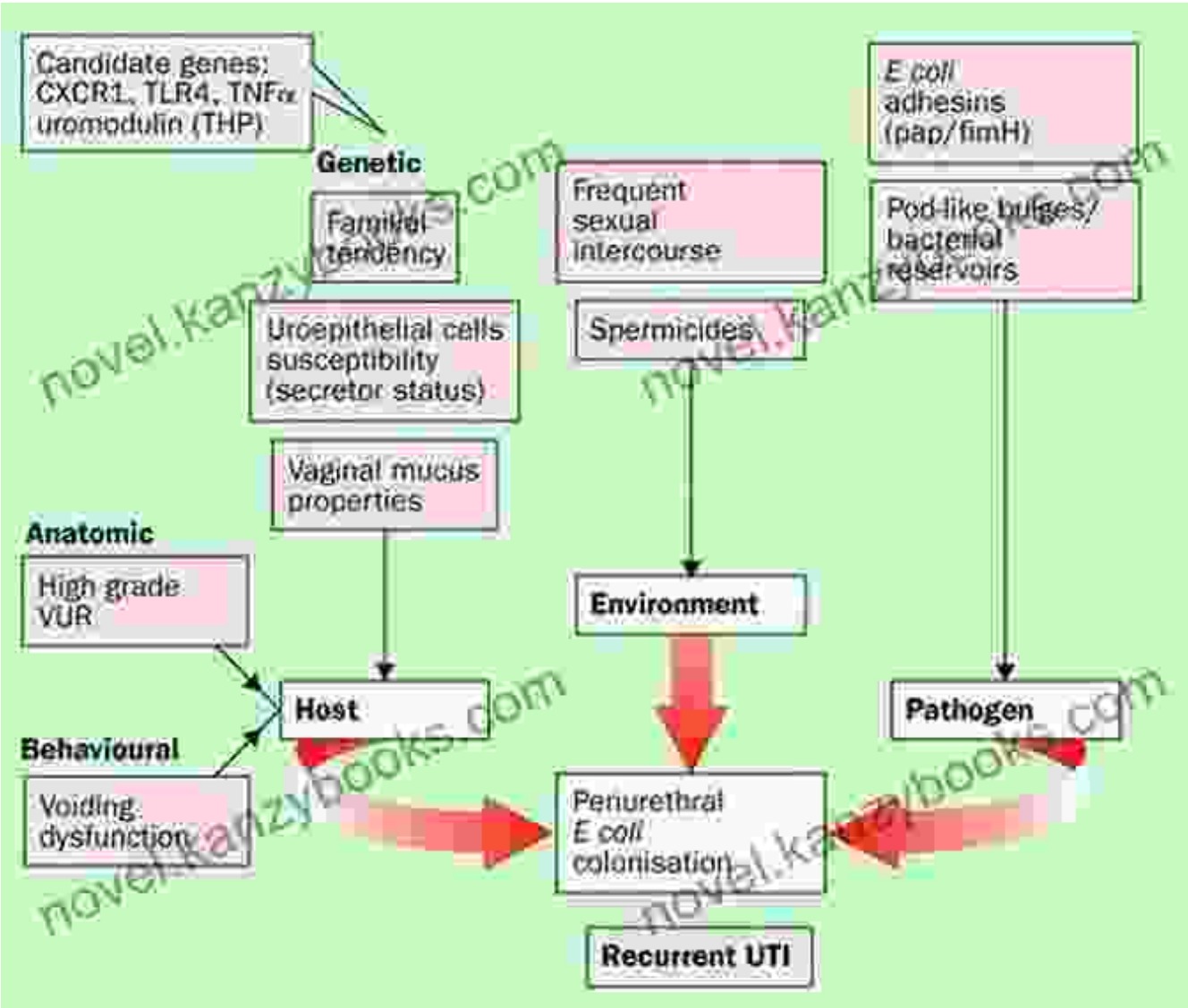

**Clinical Manifestations and Diagnosis**

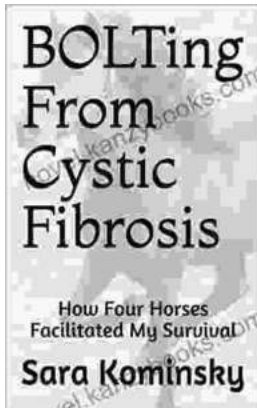
